

"When required" medicines





• Topical creams in tubes can normally be used for <u>three months</u> from first opening and <u>six months</u> for ointments

• "When required" tablets, capsules and inhalers should be stored correctly so that they can be used <u>up</u> to their stated expiry date

• Liquids for internal use can normally last 6 months from first opening-check bottle

• Your GP surgery / PCN will normally have a pharmacist or technician who can advise you.

Please do not destroy unopened medicines. Wasted medication has a huge carbon footprint.
