SUGGESTED APPLIANCE QUANTITIES & PREFERRED PRODUCT LIST FOR STOMA ACCESSORIES – QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

This guide has been developed and reviewed by the Somerset CCG Medicines Management team, in liaison with the stoma nurses from Taunton and Somerset trust (TST) and Yeovil hospital (YDH).

It will apply to most Stoma patients, however it is recognised that there will be patient specific exceptions. The GP will be informed of these exceptions by the stoma team.

The stoma team can aid in switching existing patients if clinically appropriate and after assessment by a stoma nurse. This will be on an individual basis and will be achieved by giving advice, support and samples as necessary.

Ileostomy flange/baseplate (two piece)	One flange usually remains in situ for approximately 2-3 days	15 flanges	Change every 2-3 days	
Urostomy (one piece)	Usually 1 bag every 1-3 days	10-30 bags (1-3 boxes of 10 bags)	Drain as required throughout day. Use a new bag every 1-3 days	Bags are drainable
Urostomy bag	Usually 1 bag every 2 days	10-30 bags (1-3 boxes of 10 bags)	Drain as required throughout day. Use a new bag every 2 days	Bags are drainable
Urostomy flange/baseplate (two piece)	One flange usually remains in situ for approximately 2-3 days	15 flanges	Change every 2-3 days	
Urostomy Night Bag	Night bag to be attached nightly, but replace weekly. NB. Bag should be rinsed daily	4 bags (1 box of 10 bags every 2-3 months)	Use a new bag every week	Bags are drainable/daily

Stoma Powder (Usually supplied by the Stoma clinic)	ONE bottle occasionally For short-term use ONLY. To be used on broken/raw skin surrounding stoma to absorb moisture. DO NOT use on intact/ dry skin. Adhesive Remover Wipes: These are only for use in exceptional circumstances, only by request from a Stoma nurse.

Deodorant: Patients should be encouraged to buy their own deodorant.

Garments: Used for patients to prevent a Parastomal Hernia. A patient may be prescribed **THREE** per year. One to wear, one to wash and one for spare, in agreement with the stoma team.

Lubricating Gel: These are only prescribed in exceptional circumstances as patients can use baby oil.
